## Saturday 15th March 2025 - Robertson Showground

Any person using electrical equipment (power leads/devices/appliances etc) whilst on the Showground is required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers & that all such leads/appliances/devices etc have been inspected & tagged by a licensed electrical contractor.

*Persons who do not comply with the above regulations will not be permitted to exhibit, operate a stand/stall, or compete on the show ground.*

Robertson A & H Society Inc. reserves the right to disconnect any electrical leads/devices/equipment that do not comply with the above regulation.

To avoid any problems arising in regard to the above regulations it is advised that you check your electrical equipment BEFORE you come to the Showground. Electrical leads are not permitted to be trailed along the ground unprotected from the power source. The Show Society appreciates your cooperation.

### ACCIDENT & PUBLIC RISK INSURANCE

Any accident occurring during the period of the Show must be reported to the Secretary's Office and verified during the current dates of the Show, otherwise the Robertson Show Society will accept NO responsibility for the consideration of any claims

### BEEF CATTLE REGULATIONS

1. Owners & exhibitors must be in total control of cattle, exercising due caution regarding public safety and public liability & livestock insurance.
2. Age as at April 1st, 2025.
3. All cattle must be paraded on the day of the show as Committee requires. All ribbon winners to join Grand Parade.
4. Duplicate or photo copy of registration certificate of Pure Bred cattle must accompany entries, for return on judging day.
5. All exhibits under 18 months may be mouthed prior to judging in accordance with RAS regulations. Cattle not complying will be re-graded accordingly.
6. Cattle to be stalled by 8.30 am in allocated areas & ready when Stewards call their class.
7. All bulls over 12 months must be rung. All bulls under 12 months to have a nose grip.
8. All females must be paraded with a nose grip.
9. All Poll and dehorned cattle must be stalled with neck straps.
10. A calf of the exhibit is admitted if it is under the age of 8 months on the day & is being suckled by the exhibit. RAS regulation No 6
11. Exhibitors supply own Bedding.
12. All cattle must comply with NSW Dept. of Agriculture Health Regulations.
13. Exhibitors must attach Johnnes Declaration to warrant tested free stall areas.
14. All exhibitors must attach Pesti Virus Free test certificate.
15. ALL CATTLE MUST BE TAGGED WITH NLIS TAGS
16. ALL STALLS TO BE KEPT & LEFT CLEAN & TIDY.
17. Indemnity forms MUST be signed by all competitors

### BRITISH & EUROPEAN (including Bos Indicus) TO BE JUDGED SEPARATELY

**NOTE:** Classes may be re-grouped at the discretion of the Chief Steward.

Ribbons to 3rd place, Broad Ribbons to Champions and Reserves. Cash Prizes - Classes - 1st \$10, 2nd \$5 (at least 3 entries in class).

### MOST SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITOR - BEEF CATTLE: Trophy

The winner being the highest point scorer out of all breeds. No additional points for Champions and Reserve.

## Beef Cattle Young Judging Competition

The South Coast and Tablelands Show Societies Inc (Group 5) have organized a Beef Cattle Young Judging Competition to be held on Saturday 15th March at Robertson Showground commencing at 8.30am sharp.

- Competitors will be asked to judge three groups of cattle - consisting of four head in each group, placing them in their respective order of 1st, 2nd 3rd & 4th.
- Each group will judge the three groups of cattle in rotation. 50 points will be allocated for the placement of each group for a total of 150 points.
- On completion of the judging up to 10 top marked competitors in the senior and intermediate sections will be asked to give, over the microphone, their comments on the placement of their nominated breed. A further 50 points will be allocated for this oral section.
- Two competitors, aged over 15 and under 25 years as at 1 May 2025, will be selected on the day to represent Group 5 at the 2025 Sydney Royal Show to compete in the State Beef Cattle Junior Judging Competition.
- Competitors can compete in only one Group Final but it is not necessary to reside within the boundaries of the Group conducting the Final. No competitor can represent more than one Show Society in any Group Final and no more than one group in a State Final.
- The winners of the National Final cannot compete at any level in the particular competition that they won.
- Entries will be accepted on judging morning up until 8.00am. However, to assist with administration it would be appreciated if schools could advise the number of anticipated competitors and send completed entry forms by Monday 10th March to the Secretary Sue Sharpe on 02 46580897 or mobile 0410545463.
- It will be assumed that schools not replying by Mon 10<sup>th</sup> March will not be attending and will not be catered for
