Dairy Cattle Regulations

- 1. All cattle must be under total control of their attendants.
- 2. Age to be taken from January 1st 2025.
- Heifer Under 6 months Born between 1st July 2024 and 1st January 2025.
- Heifer under 12months 1st January 2024 and 1st January 2025.
- Heifer 12 18months 1st July 2023 1st January 2024.
- Heifer 18 months 2 years 1st January 2023 1st July 2023.
- Female in milk under 2 years six months 1st July 2022 1st July 2023.
- Female in milk 2 years six months 3 years 1st January 2022 1st July 2022.
- Female in milk 3 4 years 1st January 2021 1st January 2022.
- Female in milk 4 5 years 1st January 2020 1st January 2021.
- Female in milk 5 years and over Born before 1st January 2020.
- 3. Prize winners to be on the ground and to parade when called on.
- All attendants must appear in clean and tidy condition, or in Breed Uniforms, when leading cattle to be judged on parade.
- 5. Prize winners competing in Pens or Groups not permitted to parade displaying previously won ribbons.
- 6. Loss by Disease. The signing of the Certificate of Entry of any animal will be taken as a guarantee that the animal specified is free from disease. In cases of infectious diseases being spread through or by an exhibit, the exhibitor shall be responsible.
- 7. In cases of joint ownership, points for most successful exhibitor only to be awarded to name in which the exhibit has been entered.
- 8. Premier cattle breeders of each breed to be an exhibitor on the day.
