Prize monies will be awarded to the school. The entry is to be submitted under the school name. Minimum weight of entries in this class must be over 20kg. Any entry under 20kg is ineligible to compete.</p>	<p><u>SECTION 11 – VEGETABLES</u> PETER’S GIANT PUMPKIN COMPETITION</p> <p>Heaviest Pumpkin – Youth</p> <p>Open to individual students 18 years and under as at the close of entry date where pumpkin has not been harvested in a school garden environment. Minimum weight of entries in this class must be over 20kg. Any entry under 20kg is ineligible to compete.</p>
